Chapter six - the question mark



The question mark is placed at the end of a question. It completes the sentence, and so the next word should begin with a capital letter, just as a new sentence would.

A. Imagine that you are the policeman conducting the interview with Rosie back at the police station. Write out the script, showing that you understand how to use question marks.

B. Putting the question mark in the correct place

Write out the following sentences, putting the question marks in the correct place.

- 2) Why is Kitty going to speak to her

- 6) What does Gerald buy Jude
- 7) Why doesn't Kitty want Gerald to come to the demonstration
- 8) What happens to Rosie at the demonstration
- 9) Who takes Kitty and Jude home
- 10) Why is Gerald annoyed with Rosie

C. Extension work – turning statements into questions.

**Rewrite the following statements, so that they become questions.
Take care to use speech marks where they are needed.**

For example

Statement:	Question
Helly is crying because her mother is going to remarry.	'Helly, are you crying because you think that your mother is going to remarry?'

- 1) Kitty hates Gerald because he interferes.
- 2) Kitty feels the she is being left out when Goggle – eyes takes her mum out.
- 3) Kitty leaves the essay where Gerald will see it.
- 4) Kitty deliberately acts stubbornly.
- 5) I wonder why Kitty wants to go to the library.
- 6) Kitty decides to 'give it a real try.'
- 7) Rosie is arrested and taken to the police station.
- 8) Kitty feels passionately about the disposal of nuclear waste.
